An orthopedic impairment is a physically disabling condition that adversely affects educational performance. The term may include impairments caused by congenital anomaly, disease, or other causes such as cerebral palsy, amputations, and fractures or burns that cause contractures.

Identification as a student with an orthopedic impairment and eligibility for special education shall be determined by the case conference committee based on, but not limited to, the following information:

- An assessment of current academic achievement
- A social and developmental history
- Available educationally relevant medical information
- An assessment of functional or adaptive behavior skills across various environments from multiple sources
- Any other assessments or information necessary to determine eligibility and inform the CCC
  
- Student *does meet* the criteria for Orthopedic Impairment
- Student *does not meet* the criteria for Orthopedic Impairment
