**2011 - 2012 School Year**

**Math:**

- 1) **HEAVY DUTY** 1inch 3-ring binder with pockets, a supply of paper, and at least 4 dividers
- 2) Pencil with eraser (no pens allowed)
- 3) Students will be allowed to use calculators at various times throughout the year. Although calculators are not required (we have some for students to use in the classroom), it is suggested that students have their own, for use at home (**Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS is recommended**)
- 4) Ear buds/headphones for computer usage
- 5) **GEOMETRY STUDENTS ONLY** – protractor & compass

**Social Studies:**

- 1) Pen and pencil
- 2) 3-ring binder
- 3) Loose leaf paper

**Science:**

- 1) Pen (blue or black) and pencil
- 2) 1 inch 3-ring binder with 8 divider pages and extra loose leaf paper
- 3) Headphones for use with laptops

**Language Arts:**

- 1) Pen (blue or black) and pencil
- 2) 1 inch 3-ring binder with a supply of loose leaf paper and at least 5 divider pages

**Family and Consumer Science:**

- 1) Pen (blue or black) and pencil
- 2) 2-pocket folder
- 3) Spiral notebook or loose leaf paper

**Health:**

- 1) Pen or pencil
- 2) Spiral notebook or loose leaf paper

**Choir:**

- 1) 1 inch 3-ring binder

\*\*\*\*Each required notebook or binder for any class should be separate from those notebooks or binders used for any other classes\*\*\*\*

## *Important Information About 8<sup>th</sup> Grade*
